Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation Easement Request (03-99-16)

Darlene T. Vansant - 2901 Hunter Mill Road. 77+/- acres

Request: 1. Request approval for a Creamery.

Chair calls upon Wally Lippincott to provide background information.

Stacey Vansant is requesting on behalf of the family Board review and recommendation of approval for a creamery to be in association with the dairy operation of the farm. MALPF permits a creamery subject to MALPF Board approval of the use as "Processed (value-added) farm and forest products. The use must meet the general conditions for commercial uses on MALPF easements and is subject to specific conditions. The review is provided separately.



All requested uses must satisfy the following general conditions:

a. The proposed use is a farm or forest related use.

- b. Whether the proposed use or activity "conflicts with the overall purpose of the easement to preserve the farm for agricultural and as open-space land."
- c. Whether the use has an historical relationship to farming.

Specific conditions: Some of the products must come from animals raised or crops grown on site.....remainder from animals raised or grown in Maryland or the Region.

Site visit: Board visited property and met with Stacey Vansant who will be running the farm operation. The farm is owned by her mother. Board observed the dairy facilities and the cattle (mostly Jerseys with a few Holsteins). She has about 40 head but is only milking 3 currently. Plans to produce yogurt, keifer, snack packs of yogurt, chocolate milk and drinkable yogurt. She is modeling after Clearspring Dairy in Washington Co. She plans to sell offsite to farm stores, stores in Baltimore and farm markets. Is not planning any retail sales on site. She is also not planning on bringing in any other milk at this time. She will be selling only what she grows.
