REMAND ORDER

This matter comes before this Board on appeal of a letter dated December 14, 2010 from Keith Dorsey, Director of Budget & Finance, advising Appellant, Terry Randall, that the Board of Trustees, Employees' Retirement System (ERS), voted to deny her application for membership into the ERS, due to an unsatisfactory physical examination. The Board convened for a hearing on the matter on March 10, 2011. Ms. Randall was *pro se* and Baltimore County was represented by Suzanne T. Berger, Assistant County Attorney.


During the course of the proceedings it was learned that the Appellant is no longer in the position of Bus Driver, and has recently accepted the position of Building Service Worker with the Board of Education. The parties to this proceeding have agreed that the case should be remanded to the Board of Trustees of (ERS) to determine whether the Appellant has passed a physical examination for the position of Building Service Worker as required by *Baltimore County Code* (BCC) Section 5-1-203; and whether her application for member into the ERS should be granted or denied.

Upon consideration of same, and without objection by the parties, it is this 25th day of March, 2011, by the Board of Appeals of Baltimore County




