ORDERED:



2. Appellant agrees to pay this within thirty (30) days of July 12, 2012; and
3. Appellant will contact the Baltimore County Department of Permits, Approvals and Inspections to become a properly licensed holding facility pursuant to the regulations as identified in the Baltimore County Code if Appellant wishes to sell any animal(s) in Baltimore County and/or sell any animal(s) in Baltimore County to Baltimore County residents.


