RULING ON PROTESTANTS' MOTIONS FOR RECONSIDERATION

This matter comes before the Board on a Motion for Reconsideration requested by G. Macy Nelson, Esquire on behalf of Citizen-protestants on August 26, 2015 as well as a Motion for Reconsideration filed by Edward J. Gilliss, Esquire on behalf of Protestant White Marsh Mall, LLC on September 10, 2015. G. Scott Barhight, Esquire filed a Response to Motion for Reconsideration on behalf of Paragon Outlets White Marsh, LLC on September 10, 2015, in response to the Motion filed by Mr. Nelson. On September 18, 2015, Mr. Barhight filed a response to the Motion for Reconsideration filed by Edward Gilliss, Esquire. The Board convened for a public deliberation on the motions and responses on October 6, 2015.

This Board believes that a Motion for Reconsideration should only be necessary when there has been substantive new case law or enactment of a statute not available previously, which would clearly merit a modification of a Board's previous decision.

Upon deliberation, the Board concluded that the only new law is Bill 53-15 which prompted the Order of Stay dated July 22, 2015. The County Council passed Bill 53-15 and the Bill became law effective August 17, 2015. On August 19, 2015, the Board issued an Order of Dismissal due to Bill 53-15.

Therefore, after a thorough review of the arguments made, the Board unanimously concludes that the Motion for Reconsideration does not point to any fraud, mistake or irregularity in the conduct of the hearing in this case, nor does the Board find there is any indication of the

existence of new law or evidence not available to the Petitioner at the time of our Order of Dismissal. The Motions for Reconsideration are hereby denied. The Board's Order of Dismissal issued on August 19, 2015 remains this Board's final decision in this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THIS 23rd day of October 2015, that

the Motions for Reconsideration filed in this matter are DENIED.
