AMENDED OPINION

On October 24, 2016, this Board issued an Opinion and Order in the above-captioned matter.

On October 28, 2016, it was brought to our attention that the Order incorrectly stated:

Petition for Variance filed pursuant to BCZR §1A04.3B.2.b to allow a setback of 30 feet in lieu of the required 50 feet from any lot line other than a street, be, and the same is hereby **GRANTED**.

The parties entered into a Settlement Agreement, dated July 8, 2016, which was incorporated into the Opinion and Order, wherein they agreed that the Variance relief would allow a setback of 40 feet in lieu of the required 50 feet.

Rule 11 of the Board's Rules of Practice and Procedure states as follows:

Within thirty (30) days after the entry of an order, the board shall have revisory power and control over the order in the event of fraud, mistake or irregularity.

Accordingly, the Board has reviewed its Opinion and Order issued in these proceedings and finds that an error existed within that Order. Accordingly, the Board will amend their Order to reflect the agreed upon setback.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Order is hereby amended to read:

ORDERED, that the relief requested in the Petition for Special Hearing and Petition for Variance, be, and the same is hereby **GRANTED** pursuant to the Settlement Agreement dated July
