JOINT MOTION FOR VOLUNTARY REMAND/RECONSIDERATION

Respondent, Baltimore County Maryland and Petitioner Colleen Baugher, by undersigned counsel, hereby request that the above-captioned matter be remanded to the Baltimore County Animal Hearing Board for an additional evidentiary hearing and in support thereof state the following:

- That on January 9, 2018 the Baltimore County Animal Hearing Board (AHB) upheld a
 designation of "Dangerous Animal" in Case No. DD4455 and ordered that the
 Petitioner's dog "Xena" shall become the property of Baltimore County, Maryland and
 be humanely euthanized.
- 2. That on February 16, 2018 the Board of Appeals rendered judgment in the appeal of Catherine Grasso (CBA-18-014) remanding the case to the AHB for additional evidentiary findings on the issue of its euthanasia determination and that this was the third of such remands to be issued in a two-year period.
- 3. That on or around January 15, 2018, informed by the oral arguments in the Grasso appeal, the AHB began using a new framework for making such evidentiary findings, but had not implemented this framework in time to utilize it in the Petitioner's case.
