1. Basic Services Maps

2. Report of the Landmarks Preservation Commission meeting of February 9, 2012. Mr. Miller referred Board members to the written Landmarks reports that are contained in the Notebooks.

Mr. McGinnis inquired about the status of the anticipated review of the RC 2 regulations. Ms. Van Arsdale advised that the project has been assigned to a planning staff member, who has done a preliminary review and raised initial questions. Completion of the project will take more time than ideal as the department is affected by extenuating circumstances, such as CZMP, the loss of 4 staff members, reorganization of the department to include housing, as well as budget constraints.

Mr. McGinnis spoke on behalf of the residents whom he feels are experiencing undue hardship.
