Minutes of the February 2, 2017 meeting

Chairman Phillips asked the Planning Board members if they had any questions regarding the minutes from the February 2nd, 2017 meeting. No questions were posed and the Chair entertained a motion to accept the draft minutes. Discussion and Vote

1. Basic Services Maps

Chairman Phillips welcomed Mr. Dave Thomas from the Department of Public Works to provide final comments on the Basic Services Maps before the Board takes a vote. Mr. Thomas presented the official Basic Services Maps to the Planning Board.

Mr. McGinnis asked Mr. Thomas if he was aware of a storm water problem in Lutherville. Mr. Thomas questioned Mr. McGinnis if this was regarding Roland Run. Mr. McGinnis confirmed and asked if any action was being taken on this matter. Mr. Thomas indicated that it is being addressed, but that it is not a new problem. The Department of Public Works is planning to have a new flood insurance rate map

published within a year which would help to clear up the confusion and ambiguity. Mr. Thomas concluded that there are other drainage issues in that area as well which have been ongoing for the past 20 years.

Chairman Phillips called for a motion to adopt the 2017 Basic Services Maps. Ms. Berzins made a motion to recommend adoption of the 2017 Basic Services Maps. Ms. Wolfson seconded the motion, which passed unanimously at 5:09 p.m. Absent for the vote was Mr. Gordon.
