The 2007-2008 Current Expense Budget Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund Monitoring/Technology Enhancements - Sex Offender Compliance and Enforcement in Maryland (SOCEM) Program

FOR the purpose of amending the 2007-2008 Current Expense Budget, by appropriating to the

Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund monies derived from state funds and made

available to the County through the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention.

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention has made an

award of state funds available to the Baltimore County Police Department to be used to

continue the monitoring and registration of sex offenders and to maintain a constant

knowledge of their whereabouts in Baltimore County; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 306 and 712(a) of the Baltimore County

Charter and Section 10-6-102 of the Baltimore County Code, 2003, as amended, the

County Council may accept gifts and grants, appropriate same to the Gifts and Grants

EXPLANATION:

WHEREAS, such fund remains open perpetually as a mechanism to account for the respective gift and grant appropriations and expenditures throughout the entire term of the grant period, including beyond the current expense budget fiscal year; now therefore

6	funds made available to the Baltimore County Police Department, in the amount herein
