AN ACT concerning

Purchasing Act - Signatures and the Purchasing Manual

FOR the purpose authorizing the Director of Budget and Finance to delegate the authority to sign certain contracts to certain individuals under certain conditions; providing that the Purchasing Manual may provide that the director of a certain county agency is not required to sign a certain contract under certain conditions; providing that certain purchases shall be made in accordance with the Purchasing Manual; and generally relating to the Purchasing Act.
