FOR the purpose of increasing fines imposed for violations of the county parking laws; including a contingency; and generally relating to fines for violations of county parking laws.

Section 18-2-702 (as amended in Section 1 of this Act) Article 18. Transportation Baltimore County Code, 2003 (Contingent on the Enactment of Bill 70-08)

- 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
- 2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that Section 18-2-702 of Article 18. Transportation, of the Baltimore
- 3 County Code, 2003, as amended, is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as
- 4 follows:

4	(1)	A parking meter violation is punishable by a fine of [\$16] \$20;	
5	(2)	An off-street head-in violation on a public parking facility is punishable by	
6	a fine of [\$21] \$25;		
7	(3)	Except as provided in paragraph (4) of this subsection, parking where or when	
8	prohibited is a violation punishable by a fine of [\$25] \$50;		
9	(4)	Prohibited parking on city property at Loch Raven, Pretty Boy, and Liberty	
10	Reservoirs is a violation punishable by a fine of \$35;		
11	(5)	Stopping or standing violations are punishable by a fine of [\$25] \$50; and	
12	(6)	All other parking violations are punishable by a fine of [\$32] \$50.	
13	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that contingent on the enactment of Bi		
14	70-08, Section 18-2-702 of Article 18. Transportation, of the Baltimore County Code, 2003, as		
15	amended in Section 1 of this Act, is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read a

18	(a) In addition to the costs established in the Courts Article of the Annotated Code of		
19	Maryland, the following fines are imposed:		
20	(1)	A parking meter violation is punishable by a fine of \$20;	
21	(2)	An off-street head-in violation on a public parking facility is punishable by

2	(3)	[Except as provided in paragraph (4) of this subsection, parking] PARKING
3	where or when prohibited is a violation punishable by a fine of \$50;	
4	(4)	[Prohibited parking on city property at Loch Raven, Pretty Boy, and Liberty
5	Reservoirs] PARKING AN UNREGISTERED VEHICLE IN VIOLATION OF THIS TITLE is a	
6	violation punishable by a fine of [\$35] \$40;	
7	(5)	Stopping or standing violations are punishable by a fine of \$50; [and]
8	(6)	Obstructing a fire lane or parking in a fire lane in violation of § 14-3-103 or
9	the Code is a violation punishable by a fine of [\$43] \$100;	
10	(7)	Parking in a space designated for the use of individuals with disabilities in
11	violation of § 18-2-210 of this title is a violation punishable by a fine of [\$75] \$150; and	
12	(8)	Except as provided in §§ 18-2-206(e) and 18-2-211 of this title, all other
13	parking violations are punishable by a fine of \$50.	
14	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act having been passed by the	
15	affirmative vote of f	ive (5) members of the County Council shall take effect August 17, 2008.
