## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

The 2008-2009 Capital Budget Towson Circle III Project

FOR the purpose of amending the 2008-2009 Capital Budget, by appropriating to the Capital Budget monies derived from State funds and made available to the County through the Maryland Department of Transportation.

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Transportation has made an award of state funds available to Baltimore County to be used to reimburse Towson Circle Joint Venture - Phase 3, LLP for specific improvements to the transportation infrastructure related to the Towson Circle III project; and

WHEREAS, the use of these funds complies with a Memorandum of Understanding approved by the County Council on October 15, 2007;

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 716 of the Baltimore County Charter, the

County Council may, upon a recommendation of the County Executive, amend the Capital Budget; now, therefore

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, pursuant to the power and authority conferred upon it by Section 716 of the Baltimore County Charter, that the Capital Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, be and is hereby amended by appropriate state funds made available to Baltimore County, in the amount herein specified, to the following program:

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on November 30, 2008.
