- 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
- 2 COUNTY, MARYLAND that Section 18-2-210 of Article 18. Transportation, of the Baltimore
- 3 County Code, 2003, as amended, be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments to
- 4 read as follows:

- 1 § 18-2-210. Parking in spaces reserved for individuals with disabilities.
- 2 (a) A person may not park a motor vehicle in a space designated for the use of individuals with
- disabilities, including on private property used by the public in general, unless the vehicle bears a
- 4 special registration plate, removable windshield placard, or a temporary removable windshield
- 5 placard for disabled individuals issued by the State Motor Vehicle Administration or as otherwise
- 6 provided under state law.
- 7 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor [and on conviction is subject to
- 8 a fine of \$75].
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act, having been passed by the
- affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on December 15, 2008.
