FOR the purpose of amending the 2008-2009 Current Expense Budget, by appropriating to the

Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund monies derived from federal funds and made available

to the County through the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency has made an award of funds

available to the Baltimore County Department of Public Works, to be used for completion of a

digital flood insurance rate map set for the entire County; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 306 and 712(a) of the Baltimore County

Charter and Section 10-6-102 of the Baltimore County Code, 2003, as amended, the County

Council may accept gifts and grants, appropriate same to the Gifts and Grants Special Revenue

Fund and expend the same, said fund having been established solely for the purpose of

accounting for certain monetary gifts and grants made available to the County for restricted

WHEREAS, such fund remains open perpetually as a mechanism to account for the respective gift and grant appropriations and expenditures throughout the entire term of the grant period, including beyond the current expense budget fiscal year; now therefore

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, pursuant to the power and authority conferred upon it by Sections 306 and 712(a) of the Baltimore County Charter and Section 10-6-102 of the Baltimore County Code, 2003, as amended, that the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, be and is hereby amended by appropriating <u>federal</u> funds made available to the Baltimore County Department of Public Works, in the amount herein specified, to the following program:

005-70-7027 Watershed/Floodplain Study Phase IV \$60,000

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect December 29, 2008.
