A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

The 2008-2009 Current Expense Budget Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund Maryland Business Works Program Workforce Investment Act Customer Services Office

FOR the purpose of amending the 2008-2009 Current Expense Budget, by appropriating to

the Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund monies derived from federal funds and made available

to the County through the State of Maryland Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulation.

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulation has made an award of federal funds available to the Baltimore County Office of Workforce Development to be used for employment and training activities; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 306 and 712(a) of the Baltimore County Charter and Section 10-6-102 of the Baltimore County Code, 2003, as amended, the County Council may accept gifts and grants, appropriate same to the Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund and expend the same, said fund having been established solely for the purpose of accounting for certain monetary gifts and grants made available to the County for restricted purposes; and

EXPLANATION:

WHEREAS, such fund remains open perpetually as a mechanism to account for the respective gift and grant appropriations and expenditures throughout the entire term of the grant period, including beyond the current expense budget fiscal year; now therefore

1	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2	COUNTY, MARYLAND, pursuant to the power and authority conferred upon it by Sections 306
3	and 712(a) of the Baltimore County Charter and Section 10-6-102 of the Baltimore County Code,
4	2003, as amended, that the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, be and
5	is hereby amended by appropriating state and federal funds made available to the Baltimore County
6	Office of Workforce Development, in the amount herein specified, to the following program:
7	005-087-0925 Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Customer Services Offices \$500,000

8 SECTION 2, AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this bill, having been passed by the 9 affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on March 15, 2009.
