AN ACT concerning

The 2010-2011 Current Expense Budget
Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund
Mental Health Services Agencies - Family Intervention Services

FOR the purpose of amending the 2010-2011 Current Expense Budget, by appropriating to the Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund monies derived from state funds and made available to the County through the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, Mental Hygiene Administration.

WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, Mental Hygiene Administration has made an award of state funds available to the Baltimore County Department of Health, to be used for the Family Intervention Services; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 306 and 712(a) of the Baltimore County Charter and Section 10-6-102 of the Baltimore County Code, 2003, as amended, the County Council may accept gifts and grants, appropriate same to the Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund and expend

WHEREAS, such fund remains open perpetually as a mechanism to account for the respective gift and grant appropriations and expenditures throughout the entire term of the grant period, including beyond the current expense budget fiscal year; now therefore

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, pursuant to the power and authority conferred upon it by Sections 306 and 712(a) of the Baltimore County Charter and Section 10-6-102 of the Baltimore County Code, 2003, as amended, that the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, be and is hereby amended by appropriating state funds made available to the Baltimore County Department of Health, in the amount herein specified, to the following program:
