Signs

FOR the purpose of permitting certain directional signs; and generally relating to directional signs.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

Sections 450.4.3
Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, as amended

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that Section 450.4.3 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, as amended, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
