- 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
- 2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that Section 5-1-105 be and it is hereby added to Article 5,
- 3 Employees Retirement System, Title 1 In General, of the Baltimore County Code 2003, to read
- 4 as follows:

2	(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A MEMBER WHO:
3	(1) IS IN THE EXEMPT SERVICE OF COUNTY GOVERNMENT; AND
4	(2) BEGAN SERVICE WITH THE COUNTY PRIOR TO JULY 1, 2007; AND
5	(3) LEAVES COUNTY SERVICE WITHOUT HAVING WITHDRAWN HIS OR HER
6	ACCUMULATED CONTRIBUTIONS; AND
7	(4) RETURNS TO ACTIVE SERVICE WITH THE COUNTY WITHIN THREE MONTHS
8	AFTER SEPARATION FROM ACTIVE SERVICE AND REJOINS THE SYSTEM.
9	(B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE, A PERSON WHO
10	MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (A) SHALL BE TREATED, FOR ALL
11	PURPOSES OF THIS ARTICLE, AS HAVING BEGUN SERVICE WITH THE COUNTY PRIOR
12	TO JULY 1, 2007.
13	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by
14	the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on August 16,
