AN ACT concerning

The 2010-2011 Current Expense Budget Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund Children In Need of Supervision Grant

FOR the purpose of amending the 2010-2011 Current Expense Budget, by appropriating to the Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund monies derived from federal funds and made available to the County through the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention. WHEREAS, the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention has made an award of federal funds available to the Baltimore County Police Department, to be used to fund the salary and

fringe benefits for two part time Human Services Associate positions; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 306 and 712(a) of the Baltimore County Charter and Section 10-6-102 of the Baltimore County Code, 2003, as amended, the County Council may accept gifts and grants, appropriate same to the Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund and expend

the same, said fund having been established solely for the purpose of accounting for certain

monetary gifts and grants made available to the County for restricted purposes; and

WHEREAS, such fund remains open perpetually as a mechanism to account for the respective gift and grant appropriations and expenditures throughout the entire term of the grant period, including beyond the current expense budget fiscal year; now therefore

1	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2	COUNTY, MARYLAND, pursuant to the power and authority conferred upon it by Sections 306
3	and 712(a) of the Baltimore County Charter and Section 10-6-102 of the Baltimore County Code,
4	2003, as amended, that the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, be and
5	is hereby amended by appropriating federal funds made available to the Baltimore County Police
6	Department, in the amount herein specified, to the following program:

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by the 9 affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect October 17, 2010.
