Zoning Regulations - Signs

FOR the purpose of amending the Zoning Regulations pertaining to certain types of enterprise signs permitted in the C.T. District of Towson; providing that certain requirements for projecting signs do not apply in the C.T. District of Towson; and generally relating to signs in the C.T. District of Towson.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

Sections 450.4.5(p) and 450.5.B.6
Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, as amended

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE

2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations read as follows:

3	6. Projecting sign: A sign having its structural framework or supporting elements
4	attached to a wall of a building with a face which is more than one foot from the wall at any
5	point on the face or is not in a plane parallel to the wall. "Projecting sign" does not include
6	wall-mounted, roof, canopy or awning signs. Projecting signs are subject to the following:
7	a. A projecting sign may not be higher than the lesser of:
8	(1) The height of the eaves, cornice or parapet at the top of the wall to
9	which it is attached; or
10	(2) A height of 25 feet from the base of the wall below the sign, UNLESS
11	IN THE C.T. DISTRICT OF TOWSON, WHERE THE SIGN MAY
12	EXTEND TO A HEIGHT OF 75 FEET FROM THE BASE OF THE
13	WALL BELOW THE SIGN.
14	b. EXCEPT FOR A SIGN PERMITTED IN THE C.T. DISTRICT OF TOWSON
15	UNDER SECTION 450.4.5.P., [A]a projecting sign may not extend horizontally more than four
16	feet from the wall to which it is attached, except that a projecting sign may extend five feet and
17	may have a maximum area up to 10% larger than would be permitted under Section 450.4 if the
18	sign is:
19	(1) Attached to a building on a corner lot at an angle that approximately
20	bisects the angle of the corner; and
21	(2) The only projecting sign on the building.

450.5. Structural types of signs.

1	c. If a projecting sign extends over a sidewalk or walkway, no part of the sign
2	may be closer than:
3	(1) One foot horizontally from the vertical plane of the nearest curb face;
4	and
5	(2) Ten feet vertically from the nearest point on a sidewalk beneath the
6	sign.
7	d. EXCEPT FOR A SIGN PERMITTED IN THE C.T. DISTRICT OF TOWSON
8	UNDER SECTION 450.4.5.P., [N]no part of a projecting sign may be closer than 10 feet from a
9	side or rear lot line.
10	e. EXCEPT FOR A SIGN PERMITTED IN THE C.T. DISTRICT OF TOWSON
11	UNDER SECTION 450.4.5.P., [A]a projecting sign's structural framework or supporting
12	elements may not be visible.
13	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by
14	the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on May 20, 2013.
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
