1	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2	COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County read as follows:

4	§ 13-6-204. Health and Safety Requirements.
5	(b) The operator of a public swimming pool or public bathing beach shall provide ON THE
6	<u>PREMISES</u> [appropriate facilities for the safety of bathers as required by the approving authority.]:
7	(1) APPROPRIATE FACILITIES FOR THE SAFETY OF BATHERS AS
8	REQUIRED BY THE APPROVING AUTHORITY;
9	(2) AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR (AED) DEVICE
10	APPROVED IN COMPLIANCE WITH REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE HEALTH
11	OFFICER; AND
12	(3) A LIFEGUARD OR OTHER INDIVIDUAL ON STAFF POOL OPERATOR
13	TRAINED AND CERTIFIED IN THE OPERATION AND USE OF AN AUTOMATED
14	EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR DEVICE.

16	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by the
17	affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on July 15, 2013 October
18	<u>1, 2013</u> .
