Parking Meter Zones and Parking Meters

FOR the purpose of requiring notice to the County Council of the establishment or change in the lawful parking time period, hours, days of operation, and rate for any parking meter zone; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to the regulation of parking meters and parking meter zones.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments

Sections 18-2-306 and 18-2-308 Article 18 - Transportation Title 2 - Vehicles and Traffic Baltimore County Code 2003

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County, Maryland read as follows:

2 (A) RECOMMENDATION. THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER SHALL
3 RECOMMEND TO THE COUNTY COUNCIL THE ESTABLISHMENT OR CHANGE IN THE
4 LAWFUL PARKING TIME PERIOD, HOURS, DAYS OF OPERATION, LOCATION, OR RATE
5 FOR ANY PARKING METER ZONE.

[(a)] (B) Authority. [With the approval] BASED UPON THE RECOMMENDATION of
the Administrative Officer, the Traffic Engineer may, by regulation, establish and change the lawful
parking time period, hours, days of operation, [and] OR rate for any parking meter zone, UNLESS,
WITHIN 14 DAYS OF THE RECEIPT OF THE RECOMMENDATION UNDER SUBSECTION
(A) OF THIS SECTION, ANY MEMBER OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL REQUESTS THAT THE
MATTER BE FORWARDED TO THE COUNTY COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL OR
DISAPPROVAL BY THE COUNCIL AT A LEGISLATIVE MEETING.

[(b)] (C) Requirement. The Traffic Engineer shall have the plate or device required under
§ 18-2-304(d) of this subtitle altered to reflect any change made under subsection [(a)] (B) of this
section.

16 § 18-2-308. Parking Meter Zones.

Subject to the [applicable provisions of the Code and subject to the approval of the County
 Administrative Officer] REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 18-2-306, the Traffic Engineer may, by

1	regulation, establish and change the location of parking meter zones within each of the parking meter
2	districts [when] IF the Traffic Engineer determines, on the basis of engineering and traffic
3	investigations, that the establishment or changing of parking meter zones is necessary to aid in
4	regulating the movement and parking of vehicles.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act shall take effect forty-five
7 (45) days after its enactment.
