Baltimore County Zoning Regulations

- 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
- 2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations read as follows:

1	§404.1 General regulations.
2	Limited acreage wholesale flower farms, horticultural nurseries and landscape service
3	operations are subject to the following requirements:
4	B. Controlled-environment structures and accessory structures shall be located at least
5	[50] 25 feet from any property line, EXCEPT THAT FOR A PROPERTY WITH A MINIMUM
6	OF 10 ACRES AND A MIX OF RESOURCE CONSERVATION AND DENSITY
7	RESIDENTIAL ZONING WHERE THE STRUCTURES ABUT A PRIVATE RIGHT-OF-
8	WAY, THE SETBACK SHALL BE 25 FEET, including any right-of-way line.
9	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by

the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on April 4, 2016.
