#### A BILL ENTITLED

#### AN ACT concerning

Mercantile Exposition Overlay District

FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain additional forms and expansion of commercial gaming

activities on land with a Mercantile Exposition Overlay District designation; permitting

pari-mutuel betting on land with a Mercantile Exposition Overlay District designation,

permitting certain uses in a M.R. Zone that adjoins the Overlay District; and generally

relating to the Mercantile Exposition Overlay District.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments Section 259.15.<del>D.</del>C. 28, 29, and 30 D. and Section 241.1 Baltimore County Zoning Regulations

### 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE

8	adjoins the M.R. Zone, except residential uses. The use shall be reviewed and approved in
