## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE concerning Waterway Improvement Program Borrowing.

FOR the purpose of authorizing and empowering Baltimore County, Maryland to borrow money in a principal amount not exceeding \$11,000,000 for waterway improvement projects to be undertaken and to provide that the full amount of such borrowing shall be submitted to a referendum of the registered voters of Baltimore County for their approval or rejection, pursuant to Section 718 and Section 705(a) of the Baltimore County Charter.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Section 705(a) of the Baltimore County Charter, at the direction of the County Administrative Officer, the Director of Planning has heretofore transmitted to the Director of Budget and Finance the recommendations of the Planning Board for borrowing for capital projects to be undertaken and of a character requiring authorization by referendum; and

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

WHEREAS, the County Administrative Officer has reviewed such recommendations with the Director of Budget and Finance in the light of the existing capital program and has submitted to the County Executive a Borrowing Plan for the forthcoming referendum; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive, after approving or modifying said Borrowing Plan, has submitted said Borrowing Plan to the County Council for approval; and

WHEREAS, as a part of said Borrowing Plan it has been recommended that Baltimore County, Maryland, borrow a sum not exceeding \$11,000,000 for the purpose of waterway improvement projects to be undertaken; now, therefore

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that Baltimore County, Maryland, borrow a sum not exceeding \$11,000,000 for the purpose of waterway improvement projects to be undertaken.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that for the purpose of implementing the Borrowing Plan referred to in Section 1 of this Ordinance, Baltimore County, Maryland is hereby authorized, upon its full faith and credit, to borrow money and to incur indebtedness for financing the acquisition, construction, reconstruction, extension, alteration, repair and modernization of waterway improvement and stormwater-related projects, which include, but are not limited to shoreline stabilization, shore erosion control, wetland restoration, streambank and riverbank restoration, stabilization and reconstruction, control and monitoring of nonpoint pollutants, landscaping, dredging, planting of trees and similar waterway improvement projects in residential, rural and commercial areas, engineering and other services incident thereto; the purchase or other acquisition of land, easements, rights-of-way and any other rights and privileges appurtenant thereto for waterway improvement projects and the purchase or other acquisition, installation, maintenance and repair of all

customary, temporary and permanent appurtenances and equipment and the funding of grants to accomplish the foregoing. In evidence of such borrowing and indebtedness, Baltimore County, Maryland, is hereby authorized and empowered to issue its general obligation bonds, at one time or from time to time, in various series, and in a principal amount not exceeding the amount authorized to be borrowed under said Section 1 of this Ordinance. Any general obligation bonds to be issued pursuant to the authority conferred by this Ordinance and the forthcoming referendum shall be issued and sold pursuant to Bond Issuance Authorization Ordinances adopted in accordance with Section 709 of the Baltimore County Charter, as set forth in the Baltimore County Code, 2003, as amended, and other applicable provisions of law.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Ordinance may be cited as "Baltimore County 2016 Waterway Improvement Program Borrowing Plan Ordinance".

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that, pursuant to Section 718 and Section 705(a) of the Baltimore County Charter and Section 10-3-103 of the Baltimore County Code, 2003, as amended, the County Executive shall cause to be placed on the ballot by the Board of Supervisors of Elections of Baltimore County for referendum in the general election to be held in Baltimore County on November 8, 2016, the full amount of the borrowing authorized by this Ordinance.
