Section 13-8-103(e) Article 13 - Public Health, Safety and the Environment Title 8 - Smoking in Public Places Baltimore County Code, 2003

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County read as follows:

1	Article 13. Public Health, Safety and the Environment
2	Title 8. Smoking in Public Places
3	§ 13-8-103. Smoking Prohibited in a Public Place and at a Public Meeting.
4	(E) A PERSON MAY NOT SMOKE WITHIN 30 FEET OF THE DRIVING RANGE OR
5	THE CLUB HOUSE OF ANY GOLF COURSE FACILITY OWNED AND OPERATED BY THE
6	BALTIMORE COUNTY REVENUE AUTHORITY.

8	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by the
9	affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on June 8, 2016.
