FOR the purpose of providing that an acceptable community benefit for a planned unit development is a capital improvement benefit provided to property leased by NeighborSpace of Baltimore County, Inc. for use by community residents; and generally relating to planned unit developments.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments

Section 32-4-242(b)(6) Article 32 – Planning, Zoning, and Subdivision Control Title 4 – Development Baltimore County Code, 21015

1	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2	COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County, Maryland read as follows:

5	(b) Contents. The application for a Planned Unit Development shall include:
6	(6) A statement of how the Planned Unit Development will provide a community
7	benefit that shall include one or more of the following:
8	(i) An environmental benefit by proposing to achieve at least a silver
9	rating according to the U.S. Green Building Council's LEED Green Building Rating System
10	or proposing residential structures that achieve at least a silver rating according to the ANSI
11	(American National Standards Institute) NGBS (National Green Building Standard);
12	(ii) A land use benefit, including proposing a higher quality
13	architectural design or use of higher quality building materials that enhance the development
14	for its residents;
15	(iii) A capital improvement benefit to an onsite or nearby county-
16	owned or state-owned facility, or to property owned OR LEASED by NeighborSpace of
17	Baltimore County, Inc., for use by community residents, or to a volunteer fire company that
18	serves the planned unit development; or
19	(iv) A public policy benefit promoting economic development
20	opportunities by locating the Planned Unit Development in a Commercial Revitalization
21	District, or providing workforce housing.
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SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by the
affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on October 31, 2016.
