- FOR the purpose of allowing a State-licensed medical cannabis dispensary in the M.L. Zone by right and by special exception under a certain circumstance; and generally relating to the location of State-licensed medical cannabis facilities.
- BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments Article 4D – Medical Cannabis Facilities Section 4D-102.A Baltimore County Zoning Regulations
- 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
- 2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations shall read as follows:

3	§ 4D-102. Location of medical cannabis dispensaries.
4	A. Permitted area.
5	1. A medical cannabis dispensary is permitted in the B.R., B.M., B.L., B.L.R., M.L., and
6	O-3 Zones by right.
7	2. A medical cannabis dispensary is permitted only by special exception in a B.R., B.M.,
8	B.L., B.L.R., M.L., or O-3 Zone that is located in a Commercial Revitalization District.
9	3. A MEDICAL CANNABIS DISPENSARY IS NOT PERMITTED IN AN M.L. ZONE
10	IF LOCATED IN A CHESAPEAKE ENTERPRISE ZONE.
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12	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by
13	the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on June 7, 2017.
