Comprehensive Zoning Map Process – Campaign Contributions

FOR the purpose of requiring that Councilmembers may not receive campaign contributions or hold fundraising events during the Comprehensive Zoning Map Process, and generally relating to the Comprehensive Zoning Map Process.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE  
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County read as follows:

10 DURING THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING MAP PROCESS FROM SEPTEMBER 1 IN THE  
11 YEAR IN WHICH THE TIME FOR FILING ISSUES HAS COMMENCED TO SEPTEMBER  
12 16 OF THE FOLLOWING YEAR, AS SET FORTH IN THIS PART II OF THIS SUBTITLE,  
13 THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL MAY NOT ACCEPT CAMPAIGN  
14 CONTRIBUTIONS, ~~SCHEDULE OR~~ HOLD FUNDRAISING EVENTS, OR SOLICIT  
15 CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS OR FUTURE CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS.

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17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by  
18 the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on July 17, 2017.
