AN ACT concerning

Parking

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the parking of certain vehicles on certain streets in the Dundalk Commercial Revitalization District; providing penalties; and generally relating to the parking of vehicles in the Dundalk Commercial Revitalization District.

BY adding

Section 18-2-212
Article 18 – Transportation
Title 2 – Vehicles and Traffic
Baltimore County Code 2015

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County read as follows:

1 §18-2-212. PARKING TRUCKS IN THE DUNDALK COMMERCIAL REVITALIZATION
2 DISTRICT.

3 A. PARKING PROHIBITED. A PERSON MAY NOT PARK A COMMERCIAL
4 VEHICLE HAVING MORE THAN THREE QUARTERS OF A TON MANUFACTURER'S
5 RATING CAPACITY ON THE FOLLOWING STREETS IN THE DUNDALK COMMERCIAL
6 REVITALIZATION DISTRICT: SHIPPING PLACE, CENTER PLACE, COMMERCE
7 STREET, TRADING PLACE, N. CENTER PLACE, S. CENTER PLACE, AND
8 DUNMANWAY.

9 B. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
10 MISDEMEANOR.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by the
13 affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on October 16, 2017.
