### A BILL ENTITLED

#### AN ACT concerning

Parking

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the parking of vehicles in a certain area of the Horses and Hounds

Scenic Byway; providing penalties; and generally relating to the stopping, standing, and parking of vehicles.

BY adding

Section 18-2-213 Article 18 – Transportation Title 2 – Vehicles and Traffic Subtitle 2 – Stopping, Standing, and Parking – In General Baltimore County Code 2015

# 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE

2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County read as follows:

A. PARKING PROHIBITED. A PERSON MAY NOT PARK A VEHICLE ON THE
ROADWAY, SHOULDER AREA, OR ANY GRASSY AREA ABUTTING THE ROAD
ALONG THE HORSES AND HOUNDS SCENIC BYWAY ON MONKTON ROAD BETWEEN
THE AREAS OF <del>YORK ROAD</del> <u>ITS INTERSECTION WITH OLD MONKTON ROAD</u> AND
SHEPPARD ROAD.

B. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES VEHICLE PARKED IN VIOLATION OF THIS
8 SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF \$130.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that the Baltimore County Department
 of Public Works shall by March 31, 2018 post additional language on the "no parking" signs along
 the area of Monkton Road affected by this Act that states "\$130 fine."

SECTION 2 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by
 the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on December 4, 2017,
 and shall expire two (2) years after the date of its enactment without further action by the County
 Council.
