- 21 (a) In general. In addition to the costs established in the Courts Article of the
- 22 Annotated Code of Maryland, the following fines are imposed:
- 23 (9) Except as provided in §§ 18-2-206(e), [and] 18-2-211, 18-2-213, AND 18-2-
- 24 214 of this title, all other parking violations are punishable by a fine of \$50.
