ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

Parking

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the parking of certain vehicles on certain streets in the Dundalk Commercial Revitalization District; providing penalties; and generally relating to the parking of vehicles in the Dundalk Commercial Revitalization District.

BY adding

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County read as follows:

3 § ~~18-2-212~~ 18-2-214. PARKING TRUCKS IN THE DUNDALK COMMERCIAL
4 REVITALIZATION DISTRICT.

5 A. PARKING PROHIBITED. A PERSON MAY NOT PARK A COMMERCIAL
6 VEHICLE HAVING MORE THAN THREE QUARTERS OF A TON MANUFACTURER'S
7 RATING CAPACITY ON THE FOLLOWING STREETS IN THE DUNDALK COMMERCIAL
8 REVITALIZATION DISTRICT: SHIPPING PLACE, CENTER PLACE, COMMERCE
9 STREET, TRADING PLACE, N. CENTER PLACE, S. CENTER PLACE, AND
10 DUNMANWAY.

11 B. ~~A PERSON WHO VIOLATES~~ VEHICLE PARKED IN VIOLATION OF THIS
12 ~~SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR~~ PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF \$100.

13 C. EXCEPTION. THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A COMMERCIAL
14 VEHICLE OTHERWISE LEGALLY PARKED FOR A PERIOD ESSENTIAL TO THE
15 IMMEDIATE USE OF THE VEHICLE IF THE VEHICLE IS OWNED OR CONTRACTED BY
16 A PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY AS THAT TERM IS DEFINED IN SECTION 1-101(X) OF
17 THE PUBLIC UTILITIES ARTICLE OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND.

19 § 18-2-702. PENALTIES.

21 (a) In general. In addition to the costs established in the Courts Article of the
22 Annotated Code of Maryland, the following fines are imposed:

23 (9) Except as provided in §§ 18-2-206(e), [and] 18-2-211, 18-2-213, AND 18-2-
24 214 of this title, all other parking violations are punishable by a fine of \$50.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by the
2 affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on January 1, 2018.
