1	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2	COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County read as follows:
3	§10-1-113 COUNTY BUDGET.
4	(F) AT LEAST 30 DAYS BUT NO MORE THAN 90 DAYS PRIOR TO THE
5	SUBMISSION OF THE PROPOSED BUDGET TO THE COUNTY COUNCIL, THE
6	COUNTY EXECUTIVE SHALL HOLD AT LEAST TWO PUBLIC MEETINGS IN TWO
7	SEPARATE GEOGRAPHIC LOCATIONS TO HEAR TESTIMONY AND RECEIVE INPUT
8	FROM THE PUBLIC ON THE BUDGET.

10	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed
11	by the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on April 2,
12	2018, and shall apply to the proposed budget beginning in fiscal year 2020.
