- 14 2. THE BREWERY SHALL BE COMPATIBLE WITH THE RURAL
- 15 CHARACTER OF THE SURROUNDING AREA.
- 3. A BREWERY, CLASS 8, IF LOCATED ON A FARM, SHALL BE
- 17 CONSISTENT WITH AND SUPPORT THE FARM AND ITS PRODUCTION.
- 18 4. THE BREWERY SHALL MINIMIZE THE IMPACT ON SURROUNDING
- 19 PROPERTIES.
- 5. THE BREWERY SHALL BE APPROPRIATELY SCREENED FROM
- 21 ADJOINING AND NEARBY PROPERTIES.
- 22 6. THE BREWERY MAY NOT IMPACT FLOODPLAINS, WETLANDS,
- 23 STREAMS, FOREST BUFFERS, OR OTHER ENVIRONMENTAL FEATURES.

- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed
- 6 by the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on June 18,
- 7 2018 and shall apply retroactively to any petition for special exception filed after April 1,
- 8 2018.
