- BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

1	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2	COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County, Maryland read as follows:
3	§30-1-201. Prohibited Activities.
4	(h) Disturbing or damaging wildlife or flora prohibited. A person may not, unless
5	otherwise authorized by the Director, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DIRECTOR OF
6	ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND SUSTAINABILITY, or by law:
7	(1) Catch[, molest,] <u>HARASS</u> or kill wildlife in a park or disturb a nest,
8	burrow, or den of an animal or fowl in a park;
9	(2) Damage or destroy flora in a park;
10	(3) Conduct an activity that:
11	(i) Is detrimental to the natural resources and ecological function of
12	park property;
13	(ii) Interferes directly or indirectly with the use of park property; or
14	(iii) Is harmful to human, animal, plant, or aquatic life on park
15	property;
16	(4) Mow, cut, remove, dump, deposit, or otherwise disturb vegetation within a
17	stream or wetland buffer or a floodplain located on park property; or
18	(5) Plant or cause the planting, seeding, or propagation of vegetation on park
19	property.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by
the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on October 15,
2018.
