AN ACT concerning

Residential Permit Parking

FOR the purpose of permitting the owner of a vehicle owned and used by an assisted living facility to apply for a residential parking permit under certain conditions; and generally relating to residential permit parking.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County, Maryland read as follows:

3 §18-2-407. Same-Residency Requirement.

4 (A) [Only] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN (B), ONLY a motor vehicle owner or operator
5 who resides in a residential permit parking area may apply for a residential parking permit for that
6 area.

7 (B) THE OWNER OF A VEHICLE THAT IS USED BY AN ASSISTED LIVING
8 FACILITY LOCATED IN A RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA MAY APPLY FOR A
9 PERMIT FOR THAT AREA, IF THE VEHICLE IS USED TO TRANSPORT RESIDENTS OF
10 THE FACILITY. ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IS WITHIN THE
11 DISCRETION OF THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act shall take effect
14 forty-five (45) days after its enactment.
