- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County, Maryland read as follows:
- 3 §18-2-407. Same-Residency Requirement.
- 4 (A) [Only] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN (B), ONLY a motor vehicle owner or operator
 5 who resides in a residential permit parking area may apply for a residential parking permit for that
 6 area.
- 7 (B) THE OWNER OF A VEHICLE THAT IS USED BY AN ASSISTED LIVING
 8 FACILITY LOCATED IN A RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA MAY APPLY FOR A
 9 PERMIT FOR THAT AREA, IF THE VEHICLE IS USED TO TRANSPORT RESIDENTS OF
 10 THE FACILITY. <u>ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IS WITHIN THE</u>
 11 <u>DISCRETION OF THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS.</u>

- 13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act shall take effect
 14 forty-five (45) days after its enactment.
