ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

Parking

FOR the purpose of increasing the penalty for the unlawful parking of certain commercial vehicles on a shopping center lot at certain times; and generally relating to the parking of commercial vehicles.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

Section 18-2-207 and 18-2-702(a)(9)
Article 18 - Transportation
Title 2 – Vehicles and Traffic
Baltimore County Code 2015

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County, Maryland read as follows:

1 §18-2-207. Parking Trucks on Shopping Center Lots.

2 (a) Parking overnight prohibited. A person may not park a commercial vehicle having
3 more than three-quarters of a ton manufacturer's rating capacity on a shopping center lot in the
4 county between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. unless the vehicle is unoccupied and is
5 to be loaded or unloaded at a place of business in the shopping center.

6 (b) Sleeping prohibited. A person may not use a commercial vehicle, as described in
7 subsection (a) of this section, as sleeping quarters at any time on a shopping center lot.

8 (c) Scope. The provisions of this section apply only to a shopping center in which the
9 owner of the property has posted appropriate signs approved by the Police Department stating
10 the prohibitions of this section.

11 (D) A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF \$250
12 FOR EACH DAY THE VIOLATION EXISTS.

13 §18-2-702. Penalties.

14 (a) In general. In addition to the costs established in the Courts Article of the
15 Annotated Code of Maryland, the following fines are imposed:

16 (9) Except as provided in §§18-2-206(e), 18-2-207(D), 18-2-211, 18-2-213, and
17 18-2-214 of this title, all other parking violations are punishable by a fine of \$50.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by the
20 affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on November 19, 2018.
