A BILL
ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

The 2018-2019 Current Expense Budget
Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund
Mental Health – Service Agencies

FOR the purpose of amending the 2018-2019 Current Expense Budget, by appropriating to the Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund monies derived from County funds and made available to the County through the County Contingency Reserve.

WHEREAS, the Baltimore County Department of Health and Human Services is expanding mobile crisis coverage; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 712(a) of the Baltimore County Charter as amended, the County Council may make supplementary appropriations from unexpected and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget; and

WHEREAS, such fund remains open perpetually as a mechanism to account for the respective gift and grant appropriations and expenditures throughout the entire term of the grant period, including beyond the current expense budget fiscal year; now therefore

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, pursuant to the power and authority conferred upon it by Section
3 712(a) of the Baltimore County Charter, that the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year
4 ending June 30, 2019, be and is hereby amended by appropriating county funds made available
5 to the Baltimore County Health and Human Services, in the amount herein specified, to the
6 following program:

7 005-030-1976 Mental Health – Service Agencies \$561,200

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by
9 the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect December 2, 2018.
