A BILL
ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

Historic Environmental Setting – Scott’s Tavern House and Outbuildings

FOR the purpose of establishing an historic environmental setting on property associated with the structure known as “Scott’s Tavern House, Stone Outbuilding and Log Outbuilding,” on the county Final Landmarks List; providing for the retroactive effect of this Act; and generally relating to the establishment of an historic environmental setting on a certain landmark property.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that, on the recommendation of the Landmarks Preservation

1 Commission, an historic environmental setting shall be established as provided in the map attached
2 hereto and incorporated by reference, for the landmark structure known as “Scott’s Tavern House,
3 Stone Outbuilding and Log Outbuilding,” which was placed on the Final Landmarks List in Bill
4 94-06.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that the historic environmental setting
6 established under this Act shall be deemed retroactive to ~~April 9, 2006~~ October 26, 2006.

7 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by
8 the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on December 3,
9 2018.
