AN ACT concerning

Basic Services Maps

FOR the purpose of repealing the Basic Services Sewerage Map, the Basic Services Water Supply Map and the Basic Services Transportation Map; and adopting a new Basic Services Sewerage Map, a new Basic Services Water Supply Map and a new Basic Services Transportation Map.

By repealing and reenacting, with amendments
Subsection 4A02.3.A.1.,2. and 3.
Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, as amended

BY repealing
2020 Basic Services Sewerage Map
2020 Basic Services Water Supply Map
2020 Basic Services Transportation Map, all as adopted by Bill No. 30-20

BY adopting the new
2021 Basic Services Sewerage Map
2021 Basic Services Water Supply Map
2021 Basic Services Transportation Map

WHEREAS, in accordance with Subsection 4A02.3.E. of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, the Planning Board has recommended revisions to the Basic Services Maps and submitted those recommendations to the County Council on March 5, 2021, and the County Council has held a public hearing thereon on April 27, 2021; now, therefore

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Basic Services Maps referred to in Subsections 4A02.3.A.1.,
3 2. and 3. of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, and further identified as (1) 2020 Basic
4 Services Sewerage Map, (2) 2020 Basic Services Water Supply Map; and (3) 2020 Basic Services
5 Transportation Map, and any amendments and revisions previously made thereto are hereby
6 repealed.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that the Basic Services Maps
9 identified herein and accompanying this Act are hereby adopted and declared to be a part of this
10 Act and incorporated by reference herein. The following maps are hereby adopted and identified
11 as follows:

17 AMENDMENTS:

18 A. THE COMMUTER SHED LOCATED AT THE INTERSECTION OF EBENEZER
19 ROAD AND PULASKI HIGHWAY SHALL BE REDRAWN TO EXCLUDE THE AREA OF
20 LAND SHOWN ON THE MAP ATTACHED AS EXHIBIT "A" AND MORE FULLY
21 DESCRIBED HEREIN AS FOLLOWS:

2 BEGINNING FOR THE SAME ON THE SOUTHEAST SIDE OF PULASKI HIGHWAY, 150
3 FEET WIDE, AT A POINT DESIGNATED WITH A MARYLAND STATE COORDINATE
4 VALUE OF NORTH 628782.41 AND EAST 1478470.26 AS SHOWN ON A PLAT
5 ENTITLED “FINAL PLAT, CECELIA SCHWABER, EXEMPT TRUST U/A” AND
6 RECORDED AMONG THE LAND RECORDS OF BALTIMORE COUNTY IN PLAT BOOK
7 S.M. 78, FOLIO 368; THENCE BINDING ON THE SOUTHEAST SIDE OF PULASKI
8 HIGHWAY AND ON THE OUTLINE OF SAID PLAT (1) NORTH 45 DEGREES 02
9 MINUTES 33 SECONDS EAST 1068.61; THENCE LEAVING SAID HIGHWAY AND
10 BINDING ON THE OUTLINES OF SAID PLAT THE FOLLOWING SIX COURSES AND
11 DISTANCES: (2) SOUTH 69 DEGREES 53 MINUTES 59 SECONDS EAST 70.16 FEET;
12 THENCE (3) SOUTH 06 DEGREES 21 MINUTES 02 SECONDS EAST 1947.07 FEET;
13 THENCE (4) SOUTH 82 DEGREES 05 MINUTES 22 SECONDS WEST 518.59 FEET;
14 THENCE (5) NORTH 07 DEGREES 00 MINUTES 39 SECONDS WEST 344.59 FEET;
15 THENCE (6) SOUTH 82 DEGREES 59 MINUTES 21 SECONDS WEST 365.35 FEET; AND
16 THENCE (7) NORTH 06 DEGREES 56 MINUTES 32 SECONDS WEST 985.35 FEET TO
17 THE PLACE OF BEGINNING.
18 CONTAINING 31.489 ACRES OF LAND, MORE OR LESS, WITH THE COURSES BASED
19 ON THE MARYLAND COORDINATE SYSTEM (NAD 83/91).
20 BEING KNOWN AND DESIGNATED AS #11301 PULASKI HIGHWAY – PARCEL 27, 230
21 AS SHOWN ON A PLAT ENTITLED “FINAL PLAT, CECELIA SCHWABER, EXEMPT
22 TRUST U/A” AND RECORDED AMONG THE LAND RECORDS OF BALTIMORE
23 COUNTY IN PLAT BOOK S.M. 78, FOLIO 368.

1 ALSO BEING ALL OF THAT LAND DESCRIBED IN A DEED DATED JANUARY 4, 2010
2 AND RECORDED AMONG THE LAND RECORDS OF BALTIMORE COUNTY IN LIBER
3 S.M. 29037, FOLIO 10 WAS CONVEYED BY REVOCABLE TRUST AGREEMENT OF
4 CECELIA SCHWABER DTD. DECEMBER 9, 1985 AND CECELIA SCHWABER EXEMPT
5 TRUST U/A DECEMBER 9, 1985 UNTO 11301 PULASKI HIGHWAY, LLC.

6 B. PADONIA ROAD AND DEERCO ROAD/BEAVER DAM ROAD AT A 600
7 FOOT RADIUS FROM THE CENTER OF THE INTERSECTION – LEVEL OF SERVICE F.

8 C. THE COMMUTER SHED LOCATED AT THE INTERSECTION OF CHARLES
9 STREET AND BELLONA AVENUE/KENILWORTH DRIVE SHALL BE REDRAWN TO
10 EXCLUDE THE AREA OF LAND WITHIN THE BOUNDARY OF WEST JOPPA ROAD,
11 GREENWOOD ROAD, AND CHESTNUT ROAD, AS SHOWN ON THE MAP ATTACHED
12 AS EXHIBIT “B” AND MORE FULLY DESCRIBED HEREIN AS FOLLOWS:
13 LOT ONE AND LOT TWO AS SHOWN ON A PLAT ENTITLED, ‘AMENDED
14 SUBDIVISION PLAT OF BLAKEHURST LIFE CARE COMMUNITY’ DATED MARCH 18,
15 1992 AND RECORDED AMONG THE LAND RECORDS OF BALTIMORE COUNTY IN
16 PLAT BOOK SM NO. 64, FOLIO 34.

18 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that upon the effective date of this
19 Act, the Maps adopted hereby shall be signed by the Chairman of the County Council and shall be
20 dated as of the effective date of this Act and thereafter delivered to the Department of Permits,
21 Approvals and Inspections.

23 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that Subsection 4A02.3.A.1., 2. and
24 3. of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, be and they are hereby repealed and reenacted,

1 with amendments, to read as follows:

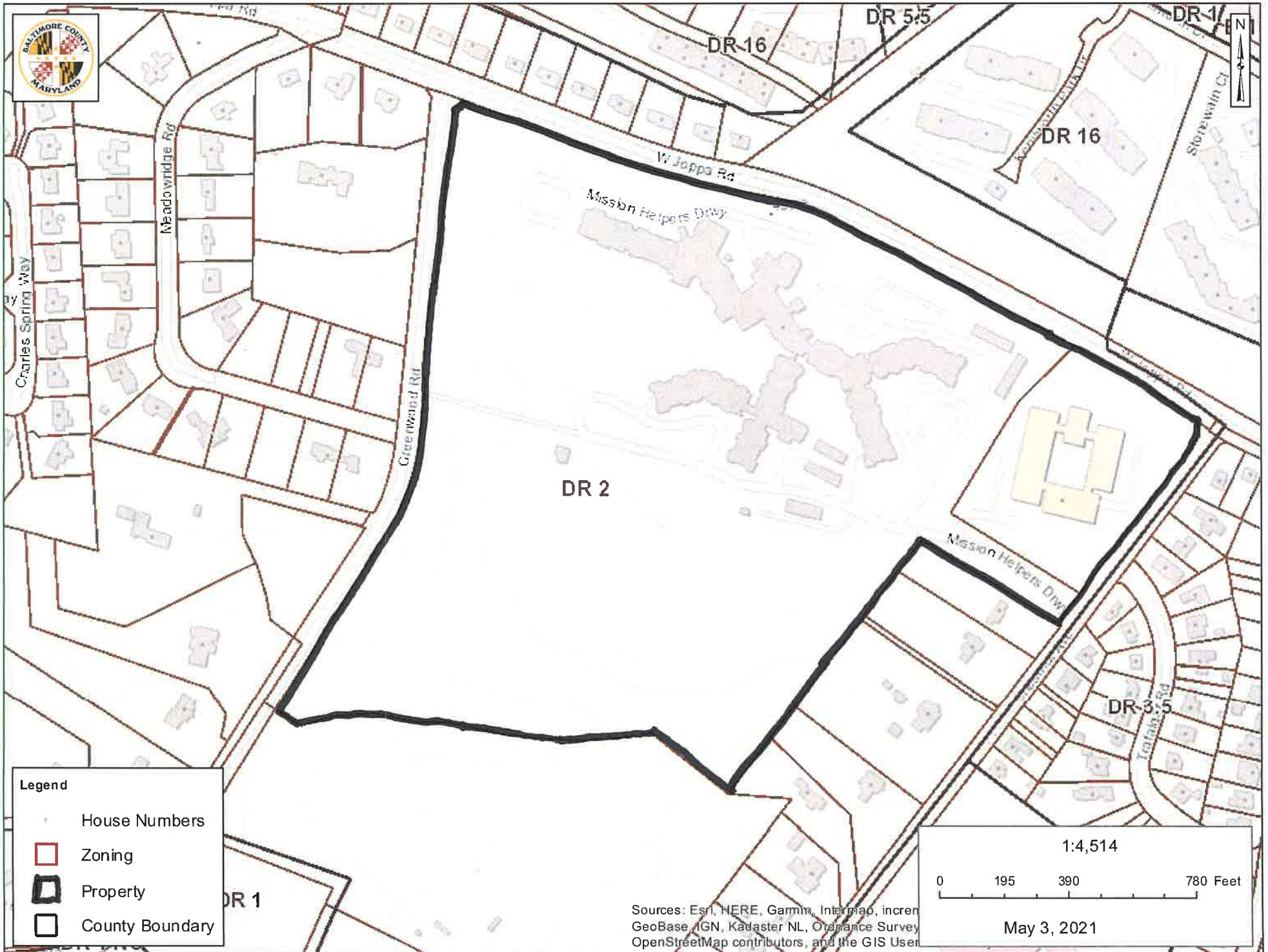
