1	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE

9	(b) The following development is exempt from the community input meeting and the
.0	Hearing Officer's hearing under Subtitle 2 of this title:
1	(1) Lot line adjustments, including the combination of lots or parcels;
2	(2) Amendments to an approved Development Plan or plat that do not materially
13	alter the proposed development;
4	(3) The subdivision of land that is in an approved state agricultural land
5	preservation district or county agricultural easement for the purpose of the conveyance of the lots
6	to the owner or the children of the owner under Title 2, Subtitle 5 of the Agriculture Article of
7	the Annotated Code of Maryland and Article 24 of the Code;
8	(4) The subdivision of a farm tract into two lots;
9	(5) The subdivision of land into [three] FIVE or fewer lots for residential single-
20	family dwellings;
21	(6) The construction of accessory structures;
22	(7) The subdivision of land or buildings in a planned office or industrial park for
23	which a Development Plan has been approved in accordance with this title:

1	(8) A minor development that does not exceed a total of three lots; and
2	(9) A development plan processed under § 235.B.8. of the Baltimore County
3	Zoning Regulations is subject to review by the Design Review Panel.

5	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by
6	the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on August 16,
7	2021.
